Focusing on artists such as Sofonisba Anguissola, Artemisia Gentileschi, and Judith Leyster, who presented themselves with confidence, asserted and promoted themselves in eras when society rarely deemed that appropriate for women.

£20/£15 on limited incomes (children must be accompanied by an adult). 15 people max. Pay in advance at the gallery or book on the link below:


